

MINUTES
PRYOR CREEK RECREATION CENTER BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY MAY 26, 2020

1. Call meeting to order.

The meeting was called to order at 17:06 by Brittain. Board members present: Rebecca Kemp, Houston Brittain, Jeremy Cantrell, Cathy Gray, Beth Moore and Steve Riff

2. Approve the minutes from the May 7, 2020 Special Meeting.

Motion made by Riff to approve the minutes from the special meeting on May 7, 2020, second by Cantrell. The minutes were approved as read.

3. Director's Report.

The director had no report.

4. Discussion and evaluation of the May 21, 2020 Rec Center limited opening.

Petition from the audience:

- A. concern that seniors are only allowed in at certain times
- B. concern that the rec center is opening too soon, questionable if the rec center is following the CDC
- C. Boys and Girls club would like to open with precautions in place
- D. Boys and Girls club precautions would include but not limited to: limited number of children (30 at the rec center location), staff will check children's temperatures at the car, questionnaire in place, children will wash and sanitize their hands upon arrival, dismissal will occur outside parents will not enter the facility (weather permitting). The boys and girls club would like to open on a Monday June 1.
- E. concern that a group of people think the public is not very intelligent, would like to give the public some credit and allow them some freedom, and scold them if needed
- F. concern that dictating how you should do things is not the answer
- G. This date 55 appointments were made. People are keeping their appointments. Prior to COVID a typical day was 150 to 200 people.
- H. The trial period for the restrictions was very short and therefore difficult to assess if it was working or not.

5. Discussion and possible action regarding opening the Rec Center to full occupancy with all programs on June 3, 2020, including the Boys and Girls club.

Kemp motioned to open the Rec Center to full occupancy with all programs on June 3, 2020, including the Boys and Girls club. Cantrell second.

Discussion included opening to full capacity is too soon.

Confusion as to why seniors were limited.

Citizens are expecting opening sooner.

The specific guidelines are determined by the PCRC board.

Biggest complained for citizens is not being able to reach someone at the rec center.

The current guidelines need to be amended.

Citizens need to take some ownership in using the rec center with CDC guidelines.

We can't compare the rec center to other facility fully, as one size does not fit all.

Need specific policies for citizens that do not follow the guidelines.

Concern that not all people will do the right thing.

Kemp amended the motion to have discussion and possible action regarding opening the Rec Center to limited occupancy with restrictions on June 3, 2020, not including the Boys and Girls club. Boys and Girls club will be discussed separately. Cantrell second.

Restrictions include:

Seniors coming in anytime

No reservations or appointments

Temperature, COVID-19 questionnaire and the number of people entering the building to be monitored

Number of days during the week are not restricted

Fully open bathrooms and showers

Basketball court closed for basketball play but open for classes

Capacity of the building set at 80, however this can be amended by the PCRC board

Hours of operation return to normal

Fitness classes as normal, the instructors will be given instructions to limit class sizes to allow for social distancing.

Pool open for water aerobics and lap swim, no recreational swimming or parties

No limit on workout session/times

No child care

Walkers on track only

Guidelines will be posted throughout the facility

This will go to the council on June 2 and take effect June 3 if passed.

Houston entertained the motion to adopt the restrictions as written to take place June 3. Gray motioned to open the rec center on June 3, 2020 with limitations as stated and Cantrell second. Motion passed.

Motion to open the boys and girls club June 1 under the guidelines of the boys and girls club made by Cantrell, second by Riff. Motion passed.

6. Discussion and possible action amending the previous Rec Center job description recommendation to include the attached changes, and then sending the recommendation to City Council for adoption.

Motion to approve by Riff. Second Cantrell. Motion passed.

7. Unforeseen Business.
