Temperature taking: will be moved to the front desk area.

Equipment on the floor: treadmills will remain unchanged, some equipment in the middle will be opened up.

Child care: follow-up with staff to confirm someone is available to work childcare and limit to 10 children.

Change to using rags for wiping down the machines.

Pool: will remain unchanged. Consider parties after we obtain more information such as how many lifeguards we have, or will have and how many people they can safely supervise in the pool. As well as limit the number of participants.
