1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Adam Anderson called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. Members present: Don Berger, Darrell Moore, Scott Miller, Adam Anderson and Arianna Derr. Members absent: Fred Sordahl.

2. PETITIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE

3. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE MINUTES OF THE JUNE 16TH, 2025 MEETING.

4. UPDATE REGARDING FREEDOM FEST.

Anderson reported that the event saw approximately 2,600 attendees and 175-200 children participated in the kid zone activities. He stated that the fairgrounds were a great venue and they hope to host the event there again in the future.

Mayor Doyle reported that the firework show was cut short due to an equipment malfunction, but the vendor has offered to provide the remainder of the show at a future event.

5. DISCUSSION REGARDING THE BLUEGRASS AND BBQ FESTIVAL.

Anderson reported that they are coordinating with the county for trash service and bleachers, and the new dates will not conflict with the fair.

Mayor Doyle stated that this is the first year that the event will be held independently by Pryor Creek Events, and he anticipates a major positive impact on sales tax.

6. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON APPROVAL OF CHECK ORDER FOR EDTA FESTIVAL ACCOUNT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$404.86.
