The Municipal Utility Board met in a Regular Session at 6:01 p.m. on Monday, July 21, 2025, with Chairman Harris presiding. The agenda was posted outside in the Pryor City Hall Bulletin Case at 12 North Rowe Street. Members present were: Mr. Garry Harris, Dr. Ken Rains, Ms. Lorri Mitchell, and Dr. Art Sixkiller. Mr. Mark Roberts was absent.

Guests attending were the Honorable Mayor Zac Doyle and Mr. Terry Aylward.

A motion was made by Dr. Rains and seconded by Ms. Mitchell to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held July 7, 2025. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Rains, Mitchell, Sixkiller and Harris.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp who presented the claims for approval.

A motion was made by Dr. Sixkiller and seconded by Dr. Rains to approve Claims #0029 - #0074 totaling \$350,495.35 for payment. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Sixkiller, Rains, Mitchell, and Harris. Nay – none.

The Board recognized the Honorable Mayor Zac Doyle who had no report.

The Board recognized Mr. Kyle Beggs of RCI Insurance Group who discussed the 15% cost increase, the 3% true rate, and the 0.84 Experience Modification discount included in the Workers' Compensation Renewal Policy #03550078 25 1 for the Municipal Utility Board for the City of Pryor Creek effective August 1, 2025 and ending July 31, 2026. Mr. Beggs also emphasized Worker's Compensation rates are based on the actual payroll during the policy period and the renewal quote was based on an estimated payroll provided by Mr. Jared Crisp which means if there was an overpayment or an underpayment it would be adjusted accordingly at the end of the policy period. Mr. Jared Crisp recommended the renewal of Policy #03550078 25 1.

A motion was made by Ms. Mitchell and seconded by Dr. Sixkiller to approve the Workers' Compensation Renewal Policy #03550078 25 1 for the Municipal Utility Board for the City of Pryor Creek effective August 1, 2025 and ending July 31, 2026, in the amount of \$48,798.00. MOTION CARRIED. Votes cast as follows: Ayes – Mitchell, Sixkiller, Rains, and Harris. Nay – none.

The Board recognized Mr. Jared Crisp for an Engineer's report which included the scheduled installation of the transfer switch for the new Wastewater Treatment Plant Generator in August. Mr. Crisp also reported on the planned upgrades to the B&H Lift Station, a sewer extension on NW 5th Street, and a bid for HDPE natural gas pipe for a high pressure gas line extension from NIPAK road to Xcaliber International LTD.

Mr. Jared Crisp also reported he would be attending an Oklahoma DEQ six (6) hour training in Wastewater Math with Mr. Travis Willis and Mr. Michael Potts on Tuesday, July 22, 2025 at Tulsa Tech, 3638 S Memorial Drive, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

The Board recognized Mr. Travis Willis who reported on the partnership between the Pryor Municipal Utility Board and Grand River Dam Authority in hosting the MESO Lineworker's Rodeo on October 1-2, 2025 at the Mayes County Event Center. In mid-September, area line crews will build a line worker's rodeo field by setting approximately fifty-two (52) utility poles at the Mayes County Fairgrounds in preparation for the October 1-2, 2025 Municipal Electric Systems of Oklahoma competition training event. After the event, the poles will be removed and returned to stock at the MUB pole yard.

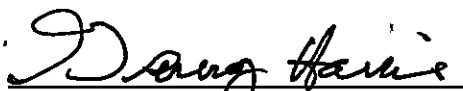
The Board recognized Mrs. Teri Hill who had no report.
