

**MINUTES
STREET COMMITTEE
REGULAR MEETING
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 23RD, 2025

THE STREET COMMITTEE MET IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, 12 NORTH ROWE STREET, PRYOR, OKLAHOMA AT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DATE AND TIME.

COMMITTEE MEMBERS: Terry Lamar (Chair), Kenneth Brashears, Bruce Smith, Tyler Brown (Alternate)

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Terry Lamar called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Members present: Terry Lamar, Bruce Smith and Kenneth Brashears. Members absent: none.

Others present: Mayor Zac Doyle and Buddy Glenn.

2. PETITIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE

There were no petitions from the audience.

3. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 26TH, 2025 MEETING.

Motion was made by Brashears, second by Smith to approve the minutes of the August 26th, 2025 meeting. Voting yes: Lamar, Smith and Brashears. Voting no: none.

4. STREET SUPERINTENDENT REPORT - BUDDY GLENN.

Glenn reported that crews removed a fallen tree on Taylor Street. He stated that a new "No Left Turn" sign was installed on Graham Avenue following an accident, and that the drainage issue at the Northeast Technical Center driveway will be repaired soon by the contractor.

Glenn stated that they are prepared to deploy barricades and signage for the upcoming downtown events.

5. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION REGARDING TWO-HOUR PARKING IN THE DOWNTOWN CORRIDOR.

Motion was made by Brashears, second by Smith to discuss two-hour parking in the downtown corridor. Motion was amended by Brashears, second by Smith to take no action. Voting yes: Smith, Brashears and Lamar. Voting no: none.

6. UPDATE AND DISCUSSION REGARDING THE SOUTH ELLIOTT STREET DRAINAGE PROJECT.

Mayor Doyle stated that the contractor plans to begin work soon. He stated that all efforts will be made to complete the work outside of school traffic hours to minimize disruptions.

7. DISCUSSION REGARDING THE DRAINAGE EASEMENT OF THE TAYLOR PROPERTY, LOCATED SOUTH OF 17TH STREET AND EAST OF OKLAHOMA STREET.

Mayor Doyle reported that the City Attorney is drafting the documents required to establish an easement.

8. DISCUSSION REGARDING THE 2025-26 STREET, DRAINAGE AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

Mayor Doyle reported that project suggestions from the Council have been mapped and are currently being planned and prioritized. He stated that notable projects include Clayton Road, Dog Pound Road, 14th Street in front of the Rabbitt Property, Jackson Street near Goldies, Cemetery Hill and several necessary drainage updates around the City.

9. UNFORESEEABLE BUSINESS.
