

**MINUTES
STREET COMMITTEE

THE STREET COMMITTEE MET IN REGULAR SESSION IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, 12 NORTH ROWE STREET, PRYOR, OKLAHOMA AT THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DATE AND TIME.

1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.

Brashears called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Members present: Bruce Smith and Kenneth Brashears. Members absent: Terry Lamar.

Others present: Buddy Glenn, Bobby Spurlock and Terry Aylward.

2. PETITIONS FROM THE AUDIENCE

3. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE MINUTES OF THE MAY 27TH, 2025 MEETING.

5. STREET SUPERINTENDENT REPORT - BUDDY GLENN.

Glenn reported that they are almost finished repainting crosswalks. He stated that they have also been working on concrete repairs, MUB repairs and mowing rights-of-way. Glenn also stated that interviews for the new B Operator begin this week and he hopes to make a selection soon.

Glenn reported that the new street sweeper has now been tagged and insured, and they plan to complete a full sweep of the city. He stated that they will be declaring the old sweeper surplus at Council soon.

DISCUSS, POSSIBLY RECOMMEND COUNCIL ACTION TO ACCEPT A QUOTE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,859.96 FROM SUBURBAN CHEVROLET FOR AN ENGINE FOR THE 2008 CHEVY SILVERADO 3500 TO BE PAID FROM STREET CAPITAL OUTLAY ACCOUNT #14-145-5411. ONE OTHER QUOTE WAS RECEIVED FROM PRYOR CHEVROLET BUICK GMC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,583.38.

Motion was made by Smith, second by Brashears to recommend Council action to accept a quote in the amount of \$19,859.96 from Suburban Chevrolet for an engine for the 2008 Chevy Silverado 3500 to be paid from Street Capital Outlay Account #14-145-5411. One other quote was received from Pryor Chevrolet Buick GMC in the amount of \$20,583.38. Motion was amended by Smith, second by Brashears to accept the high quote from Pryor Chevrolet Buick GMC in the amount of \$20,583.38 to be paid from Street Capital Outlay Account #14-145-5411 in the best interest of the city. 9. UPDATE AND DISCUSSION REGARDING SOUTH ELLIOTT STREET DRAINAGE PROJECT.

Mayor Doyle reported that they will soon begin work on the project and expect minimal road closures.
