

**MINUTES  
BUDGET & PERSONNEL COMMITTEE MEETING  
CITY OF PRYOR CREEK, OKLAHOMA  
TUESDAY, MARCH 10, 2026 AT 5:30 PM**

The Budget & Personnel Committee of the City of Pryor Creek, Oklahoma met in regular session on the above date and time in the Council Chamber upstairs at City Hall, 12 North Rowe Street in Pryor Creek, Oklahoma. This meeting was followed immediately by a meeting of the Pryor Public Works Authority. **1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER.**

Choya Shropshire called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Committee members present included Lori Bradshaw, Charles Tramel and Choya Shropshire. Members absent: none.

Others present: Zac Doyle and Kimmie Shropshire.

**b. DISCUSS, POSSIBLY APPROVE MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 13<sup>TH</sup>, 2026 REGULAR MEETING.**

**2. MAYOR'S REPORT.**

**a. TAX REPORTS.**

Mayor Doyle reported that Sales and Use Tax revenue has increased significantly, with year-to-date revenue surpassing the total revenue from the 2024-2025 fiscal year with 3 months remaining in the year.

**b. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATUS.**

Mayor Doyle stated that he intends to continue cost-saving measures to finish the year strong, with surplus funds projected to be near \$500,000.00.

**c. GENERAL FUND BUDGET REVIEW.**

Mayor Doyle reported a surplus in the City Hall Capital Outlay budget, noting that roof repairs were completed under the projected cost. He stated that the remaining funds will be reallocated toward ongoing City Hall improvements and the installation of new flooring at the Graham Community Building following its renovation.
