PRYOR CREEK REC BOARD MINUTES APRIL 9TH, 2026

1. Call meeting to order
2. Petitions from the audience (None)
3. Discuss, possibly approve the minutes from March meeting. David made motion to approve, Ben 2nd.

Action Items:

- a) Discussed the bids regarding the landscaping/groundskeeping for the period of time April 1st to October 31st season. Grass with Class Mowing - \$25,969.50; Green Thumb - \$12,550.00. A motion was needed to show the council approved the bid by Green Thumb. Motion made by Ben, David 2nd. All approved the motion.
- b) Discussed Power Plate – Cost Comparison:
 - a. All-American Fitness - \$7,630.00
 - b. Push Pedal Pull - \$7,256.00

Ben thought we should check into leasing vs buying outright. Approval is contingent on which is more cost effective. Tabled until further information regarding lease vs purchase.

Director's Report:

- Mike is working on bids for the locker rooms. He will have information for us by the May meeting.
- **Maintenance:** A new cleaning crew has been hired and Mike reports that they are doing a good job at this time.
- **Easter Egg Hunt:** The Easter Egg Hunt was successful with over 30 participants.
- **Pickleball:** The coatracks/hooks have been installed in the gym for pickleball bags, coats, etc. use. The new bleachers were too small and will be moved to the pool area. They have been replaced with benches.
- Mike informed us that the Health Fair will be held at the Rec Center on June 3rd.
- Mike is talking to the mayor regarding security cameras being tied into the Police Department. New cameras are needed or need to be cleaned. A local company may be contracted to the city. Controlled access also needs a camera.
- The Cherokee Nation will not be taking the rock wall so it either needs a way to possibly be stored or contact the donors and ask what they would like to do with it.
