DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER AND THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC, THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED CITY COUNCIL MEETING ON FEBRUARY 18TH, 2025, WAS CANCELLED.

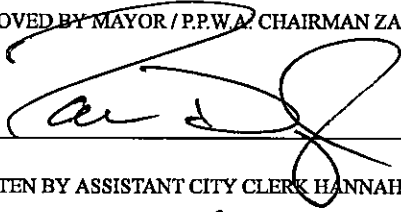
